II. Welcome and Introductions	Dr. Marti Baum, Chair  Linda Stratton, Executive Director, San Bernardino County Medical Society	Dr. Baum thanked IEHP for donation of venue and lunch. Dr. Baum also thanked Linda Stratton for arranging all the appropriate meeting materials.  Linda asked committee members to verify their listed contact information on the sign in sheet. IV. Old Business  A. Head Lice Policy	Tom Hernandez	The Public Health Officer recommends that if a child has head lice, the child should be sent home with medication and be allowed to return to school the next day following a routine examination and screen.  Linda asked if the information can be posted on the SBCMS website. Tom responded that he will convert the file to PDF format and provide to Linda Stratton.	<i>None</i>
A. School District Health Forms & Website Information	Christine Ridley, RN	Christine said that the School District Health Forms & Website information was sent to SBC medical society and that they have placed them on their website.	<i>None</i>

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		<p>Christine said if you go to <a href="http://www.sbcms.org">www.sbcms.org</a> it's on the right of physicians who care picture, click on the School Nurse Physicians Collaborative and that link will take you there.</p> <p>Christine said the Orange County rumor of having all their forms on one of their hospital's website is false, so we will be ahead of OC. Christine announced two forms are posted on the SBCMS website – the Medication Administration and Physical Education form. San Bernardino County School District's logo is on each form. We hope to have our diabetic form approved and posted in April. We plan next year to move the school health forms into a sub committee that will work on the forms. This will reduce discussion at full committee meetings. Suggestion came from Linda Stratton that we have an article in SBC medical society's communications notifying everyone that they can download the forms on the SBCMS website. Once these forms are on the website we will not be updating them more than once a year or possibly every two years.</p>	
C. Dental Care Bill Passed	Christine Ridley, RN	<p>Christine said there's a Dental Bill and letter in the packet that went out to the Superintendent, Nurses, Child Welfare people in our County, but she thought the physicians would want to know about this because it's an interesting Bill. It is basically asking school districts whether or not children have had dental care and whether they've been assessed in a dental office. Christine said that one of the things she thinks many people are assuming, is that they want the schools to do the assessment and she just wanted the group to know that this whole dental bill is really just to collect data for the dental association to find out how many children in CA don't have dental care and that's all it is. We don't want</p>	None

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		<p>any school district scrambling to do the assessment or working overtime on this, we just want them to follow the directions of the state in providing the data that they're requesting. Christine stated that the form was created by the CA Dept. of Education and while we may not like it, it's the one we are stuck with right now and no one may change it. It has been stated that some districts are starting to change the form and we want to make sure that everybody knows that it cannot be changed. We will be working with this Bill for the next couple of years and then once the information is actually compiled by the State of CA, I have a feeling that we'll see some legislation coming down that will require something on the part of schools or some mechanism for getting children to dental services, we'll see how this all comes down as we go through this.</p> <p>It is not recommended that children have this done in order to attend school. They take the form to the dentist and it should show carries with fillings or carries without fillings and that's it. It is clear to the Dental Society that if they have carries with fillings then there is a dental connection some place, without means that they don't. If parents don't have the form, then sign a waiver. The American Dental Society is only looking for data right now. A dentist or hygienist must do this assessment.</p> <p>Christine asked IEHP staff if dental care is provided as a benefit. Danni VanGorder stated IEHP does not cover dental. It is a carve-out. All Med-Cal members are eligible, but children are required to have a dental exam every year from age 3 through 21.</p>	
D. Breathmobile Arrival	Christine Ridley, RN	Christine said they have started the Breathmobile program and it's off the ground. We actually met 2/7/07	

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		with several of the districts that have been invited to participate the first time around. Those districts are Rialto, Fontana, Colton, Redlands, Chaffey, and San Bernardino. They have been asked to identify some sites and to identify some asthmatics in that area. The Breathmobile will be working on a contract memoranda of understanding and the whole procedure on how to get kids referred and signed up for this, and it should be very exciting. It's great that they are able to get people to do this and all the great equipments, but I would like to see this information sent out to the child's physician.	
V. New Business A. Obesity Report Cards County	Christine Ridley, RN	Obesity Report Card: There's a lot of pro's and con's, some people feel that it's a very good idea to put the child's BMI on the report card. Some feel it's a self-esteem issue and they don't want to go there, but I just wanted to raise your awareness to the fact that there are some districts that are doing it. I don't know of any in this area that's doing it but I wanted to ask if anybody knew. There's an article on the Obesity Report card in your packet; it is the health library report card. It is more of sharing and being aware that it's happening in some areas.	<i>None</i>
A. STD Numbers and Vaccine	Dr. Marti Baum, Chair	STD numbers on vaccine, this came from Charlotte Smith at the County. She has broken out some of the STD rates throughout the different counties, and teen birthrates. You can compare our county to others. Also, we are looking at the whole issue of the HPV Vaccine. Some states including California have a proposal on the table to make it a requirement. There have been some opposition, but like all other vaccine, parents can sign a waver saying they don't want their child to get this vaccine. They are connecting strains of the HPV virus to cervical cancer as well as some penile problems. The Pharmaceutical companies are pushing this vaccine.	<i>None</i>
