It is the Medical Society's privilege to honor Carl Jansen, M.D. as a highly skilled radiologist and a leader in San Bernardino County hospitals for more than 40 years. His dedication to the progress and improvement of his specialty is recognized and appreciated throughout our county by his colleagues and his patients. He has always exemplified the well-trained radiologist skilled in the state-of-the art application of diagnostic methods and tools.

A 1963 alumnus of Loma Linda University School of Medicine, Dr. Jansen trained with a pioneer in the use of computers in diagnostic imaging. He completed a residency in Radiology at the University of Missouri in Columbia. He participated in building a nuclear reactor and founded the first Department of Nuclear Medicine in Columbia. He received an Atomic Energy Commission Radiologic Physics Fellowship, the James Picker Advanced Fellow in Academic Radiology, and an American College of Radiology Fellowship. An accomplished flyer and a member of LIGA International, he set up clinics in remote locations in Mexico and read x-rays for indigent patients on the Navajo Reservation.

Dr. Jansen is a former director of nuclear medicine at Loma Linda University Medical Center and the radiology department of San Bernardino County Medical Center, where he also was Medical Director. He continued as chair at Arrowhead Regional Medical Center where his forward thinking was responsible for a filmless radiology department on the leading edge of technology. Dr. Jansen is currently Chief of Radiology at the Jerry Pettis Memorial Veterans Administration Hospital in Loma Linda. He is an honored alumnus of Loma Linda School of Medicine and recipient of a San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors Resolution, dated April 2, 1979.

Our Medical Society has reaped the benefits of Dr. Jansen's wisdom and leadership abilities. We appreciate his willingness to serve as vice-chair of the Credentials and Professional Review Commission and on the Board of Directors and Executive Committee, leading to the presidency in 1986-87.

Therefore, it is with great pleasure that we honor Carl Jansen, M.D. and present to him the prestigious 2008 William L. Cover, M.D. Award for Outstanding Contribution to Medicine in deep appreciation of a lifetime of service to medicine and the people of San Bernardino County.
